How do we use it? - **positive sentence**

person + **used to** + verb (infinitive)

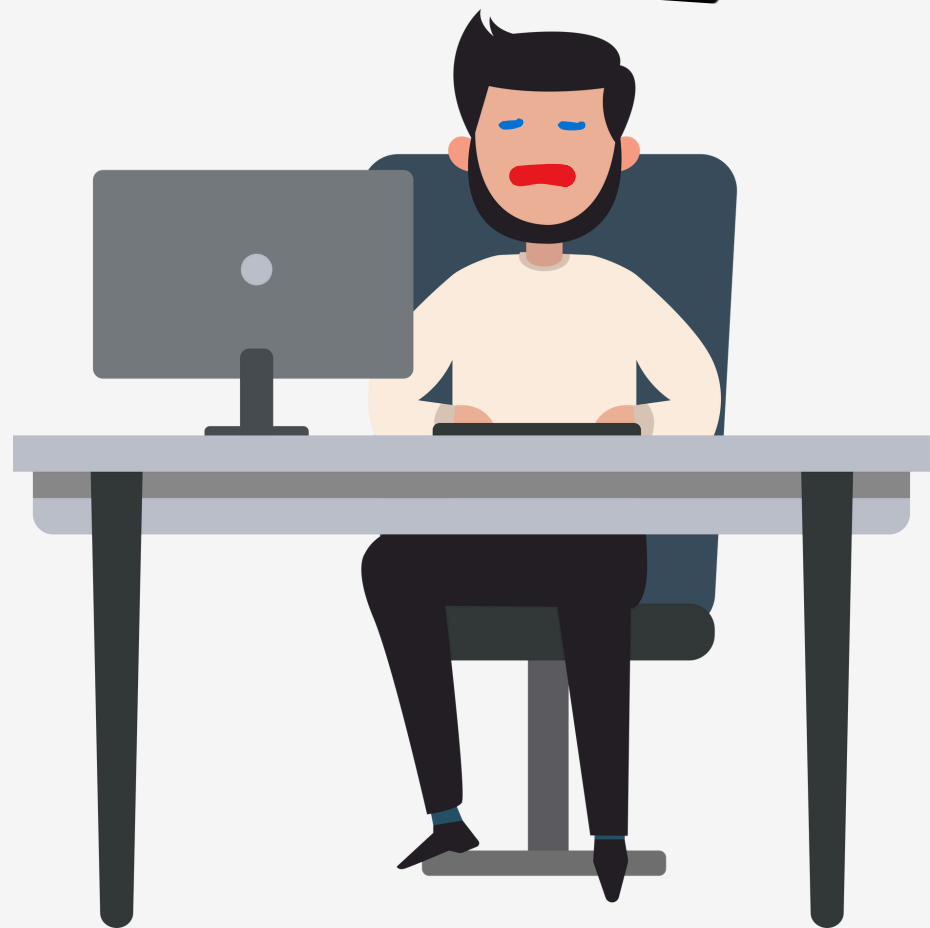
I **used to** smoke.

She **used to** play tennis.

They **used to** live in New York.

Hi there, my name is Tom.  
I **used to walk** to work so  
I **used to hurry** in the  
mornings.



Now I drive to

more.



Hello, I'm Betty.  
I **used to be** younger.  
I **used to have** long  
hair.



Now I am older  
and have short  
hair.

**When** do we use it?

When we talk about a past situation that is no longer true.

**How** do we use it? - **negative sentence**

**person** + **didn't use to** + **verb** (infinitive)

**I didn't use to work.**

**He didn't use to travel** a lot.

**We didn't use to do** online shopping.

This is Martha.

She didn't use to have kids.  
She used to be single.

Now Martha is  
married and have  
two kids.



This is little Brian. **He**  
**used to be** sad, because  
**he didn't use to have** a  
dog.



Now little Brian has  
a dog and is very  
happy.

**How** do we use it? - **question**

**did** + **person** + **use to** + **verb** (infinitive) ?

**Did you use to go** to concerts?

**Did people use to sleep** longer?

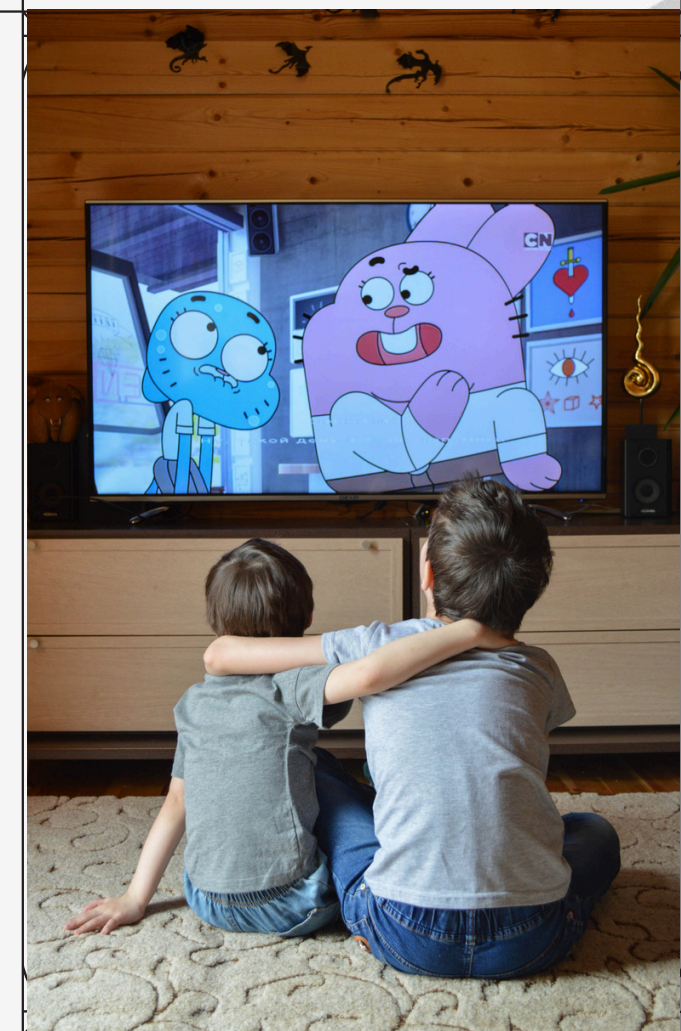
What **did you use to eat**?



Did you use to have cereal for breakfast?



Did you use to go to sleep early?



Did you use to watch cartoons on TV?

Did you use to play with toys?



Yes, I did.

No, I didn't.

What music did you use to listen to?



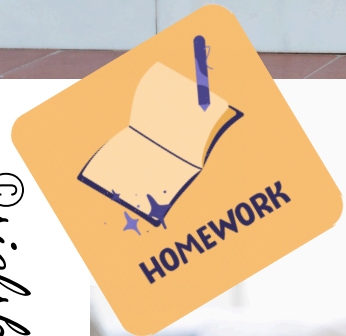
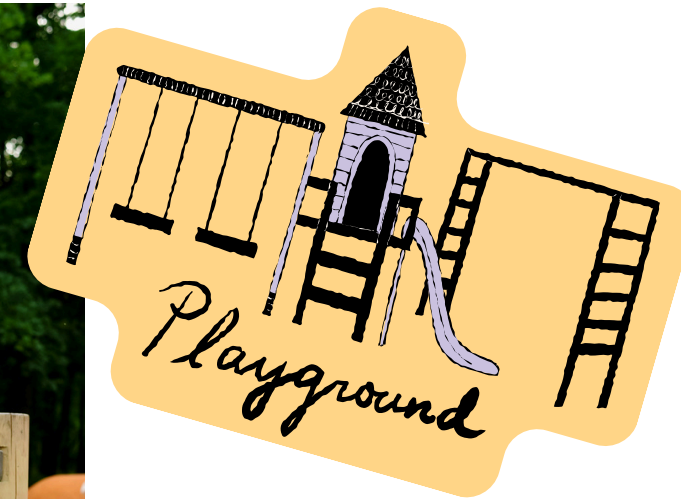
